Since 1997 Nadia Miller has been La Prairie Vice President of Brand Development International. She joined La Prairie New York in 1991 as Senior Vice President for the Western Hemisphere covering the US, Canada, Central America, Latin and the Caribbeans. In 1994 she was transferred to Europe as Director of Business Development for La Prairie, Juvena and Donna Karan.

Nadia Miller began her career in cosmetics in 1977 at Sanofi Beauté in New York working for Van Cleef and Arpels and Stendhal. In 1978, she joined Parfums Hermès where she occupied different positions, including Promotions Manager and Director of Sales and Marketing. In 1986, Nadia Miller entered Parfums Cartier as Director of Sales and Marketing. She then joined Alfin Inc. where she launched Glycel, the cosmetic line of Doctor Christiaan Barnaard. Nadia Miller was appointed Senior Vice President of the company, managing all treatment and fragrance lines.

Born in 1951, of both French and American nationality, Nadia Miller studied in France where she gained her “Baccalauréat” with “bien” grade at the Lycée de Chartres, her “Hypokhagnes” at Lakanal in Paris and her language degree at the University of Sorbonne Nouvelle.
